

EFFECTS OF COMPUTER TRAINING PROGRAMMES ON ALLEVIATION OF UNEMPLOYMENT AMONG SECONDARY SCHOOL LEAVERS IN ILE-IFE METROPOLIS, OSUN STATE, NIGERIA.

Abstract

As a fall out of admission problems confronting young school leavers, some young adults are mostly idle. Their enrolment in computer training programmes then becomes a way out of their idleness. This study consequently investigated the impact of computer training programmes undertaken by these young adults on alleviation of unemployment among young school leavers in Ile-Ife metropolis, Osun State, Nigeria. Subjects were randomly sampled for the study. The data were analysed using frequency and regression statistics. The results showed that majority of those who were successfully trained had been employed by private business centres though some of them were yet to be employed. Suggestions were then made based on these findings.
